PROSODIE launches the 1st fixed-mobile convergence iPhone App for major accounts

PROSODIE completes its IP telephony offer and allows its customer companies to manage their land line from the application One2IP on their iPhone.

The employees of PROSODIE's customer companies may remotely access their call log with calling name presentation, access, read and delete voicemails, manage call forwarding, activate fixed-mobile convergence (simultaneous ringing of two terminals) or search for someone in the company directory and then start the call in one click.

This new fixed-mobile convergence application provides true added value in terms of productivity and efficiency. It also generates ROI by reducing the costs due to mobile communications.

This application also works with third-party telephony solutions, even analogic, allowing customer companies of PROSODIE which have not migrated to IP telephony to benefit from functionalities previously reserved for IP environments.

A WAP version of the application that works with all terminals will be released soon, as well as versions for all smartphones currently on the market. Therefore PROSODIE's IP telephony offer is becoming universal for all major accounts.
